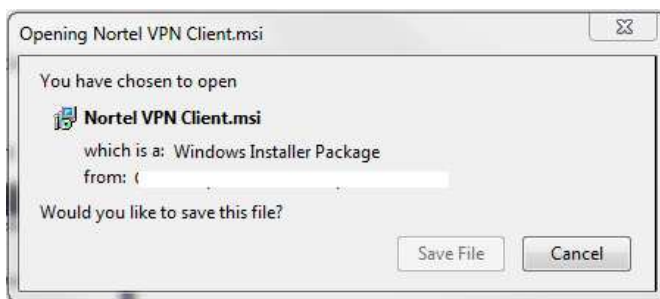




ORH VPN Installation

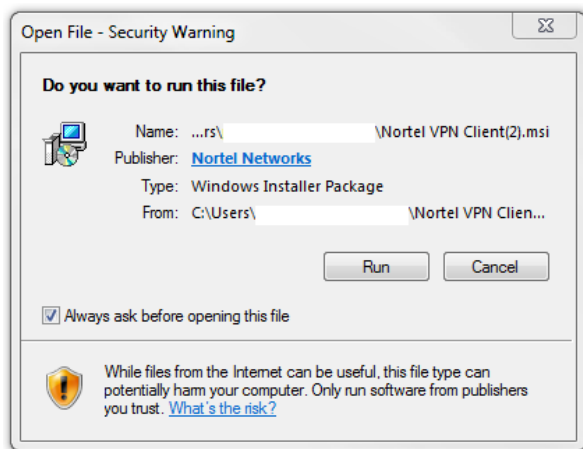
Click [here](#) to begin the VPN installation.

Click **Run (or Save File if Run is not an option)**

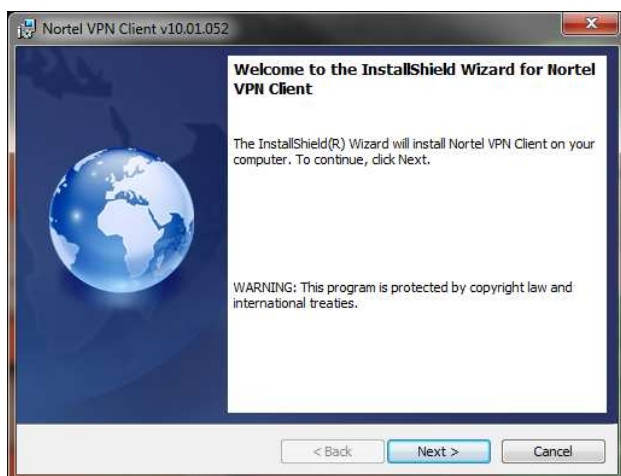


If you had to save the file , go to the file location and double click it

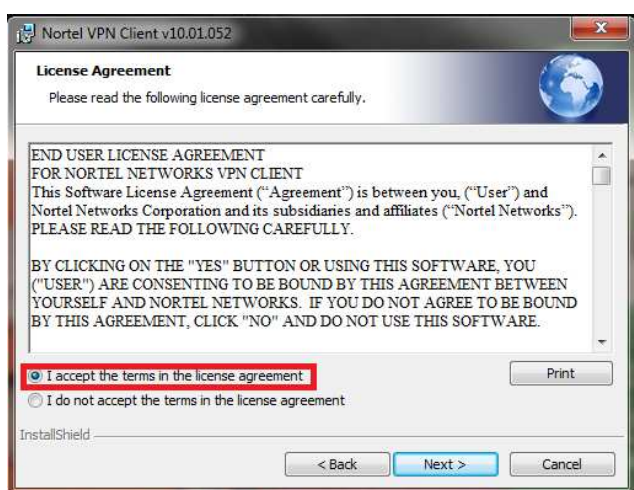
If prompted for “**Open File - Security Warning**” , select **Run**



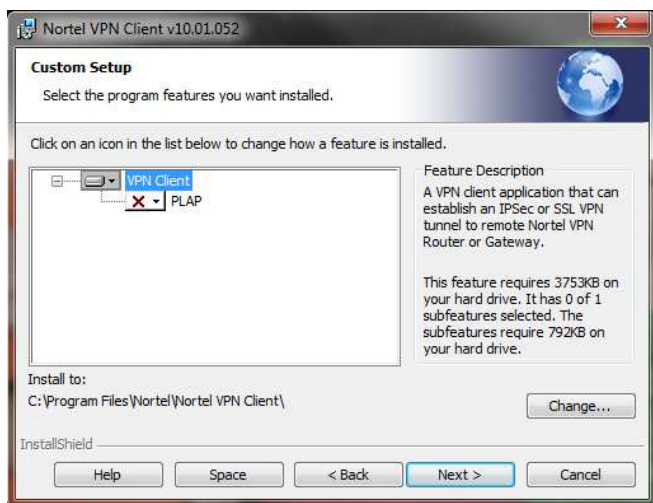
On the Welcome Screen, select **Next**



On the License Agreement Screen, select “I accept the terms in the license agreement” , then **Next**



On the Custom Setup Screen, select **Next**



On the Ready to Install Screen, select **Install**



On the User Account Control Screen, select **Yes**

On the Windows Security Screen, check “always trust software from Nortel Networks” **box**, then select **Install**



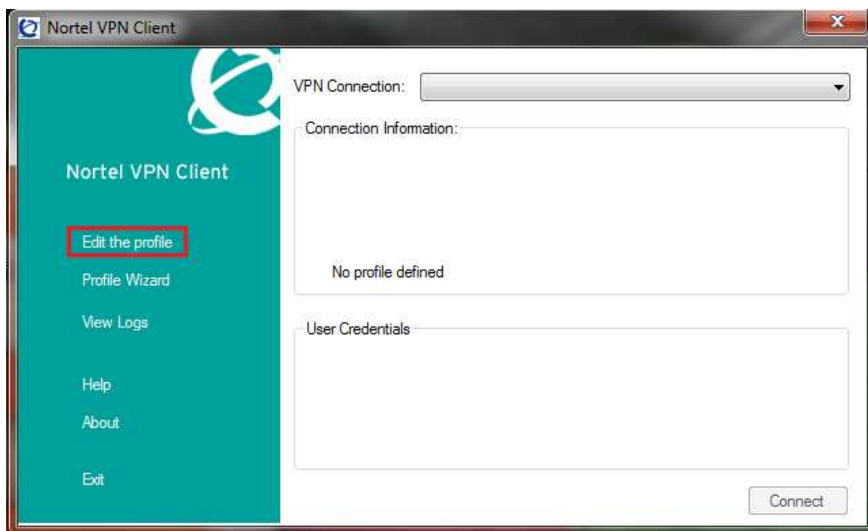
On the Installation Complete screen, select **Finished**

REBOOT the PC. This isn't technically required, but is HIGHLY recommended

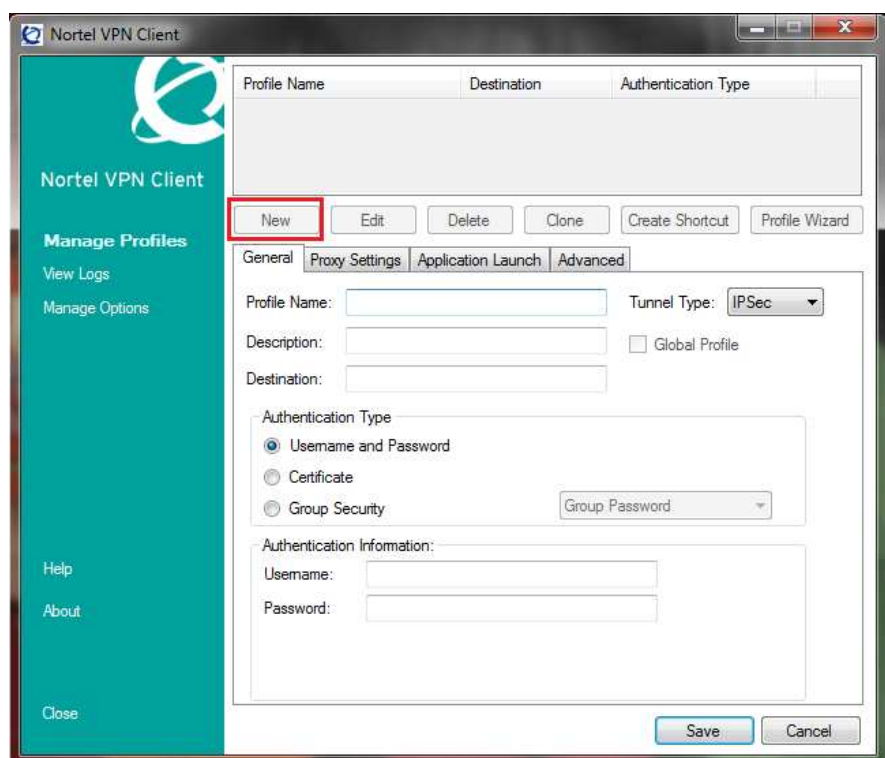
From the Desktop , double click the Icon “ Nortel VPN Client”



On the Nortel VPN Client Screen, select **“Edit the Profile”**



Select “New” (highlighted below)



The rest of the screen should no longer be greyed out

In the Profile Name Field, enter **Orlando Health VPN**

In the Description Field, enter **Orlando Health VPN**

In the Destination Field, enter **RC1.ORHS.ORG**

Under Authentication Type:

Check **Group Security** (the Group Password Box will no longer be greyed out. Do not change it)

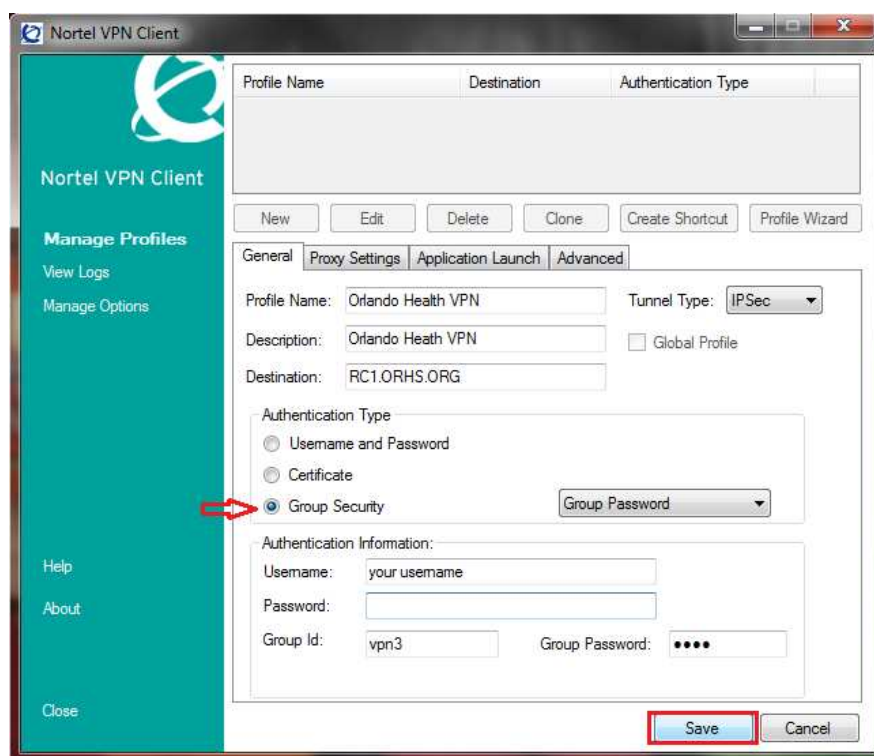
Under Authentication Information:

In the Username Field, Enter your username

In the password field, leave it blank (you will enter it while connecting)

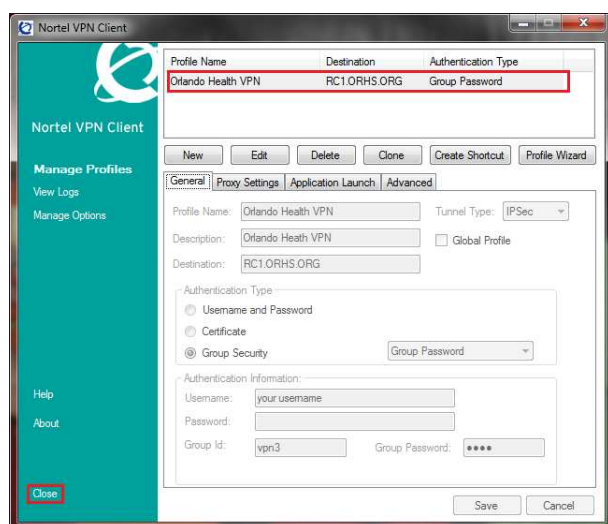
Enter **vpn3** (all lowercase) for **both** the **Group ID** and **Group Password** fields

Select **Save**



Verify that there is now an entry under profile name

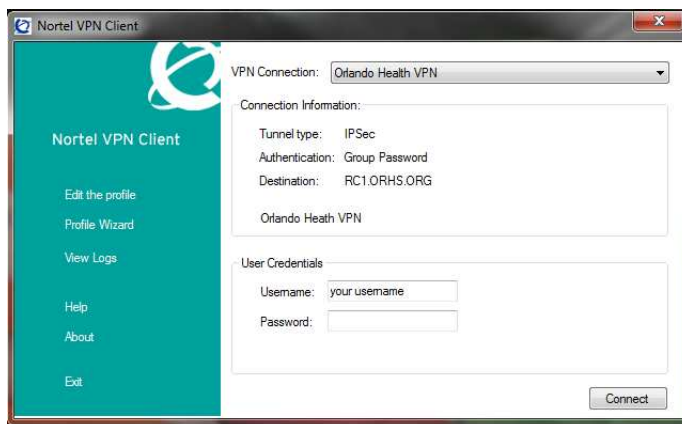
Select Close (highlighted below)



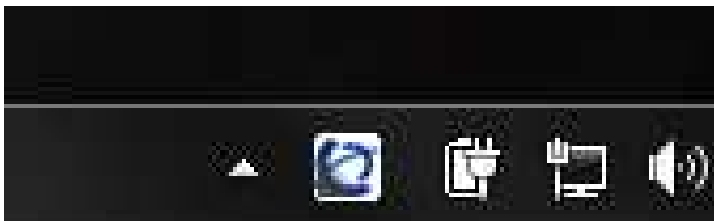
Enter your **User ID** in the User Name field

Enter your **ORH Domain Password** in the Password field

Select **Connect**



Upon successful connection you should see this icon on the system tray.



To disconnect, right click and select **Disconnect Contivity VPN**, then **Yes**
